PETROMAKS 2 aims to generate new knowledge and technology for:

- optimal utilisation of Norwegian petroleum resources and
- enhance the competitiveness of the Norwegian continental shelf compared with other petroleum provinces in relation to costs, greenhouse gas emissions and the environment.




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PETROMAKS 2: From strategic basic research to innovation

- 5. Major accidents and the working environment



22nd licensing round - announcement

26.06.2012 Today, 26 June, the Ministry of Petroleum and Energy (MPE) has announced the 22 nd licensing round on the Norwegian shelf. Eighty-six blocks/parts of blocks are being announced in this round; 14 in the Norwegian Sea and 72 in the Barents Sea.





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


The downturn in the oil and gas sector R&D investments from operators on Norwegian Continental Shelf





The downturn in the oil and gas sector PETROMAKS 2 applications



Most important change:

 A large increase in applications for Researcher projects (FP)



The 2018 calls for proposals

- The calls will be published early May
 - Researcher project (dead-line September 12th)
 - Knowledge-building project for industry, including a joint call with FINEP (Brasil) (dead-line September 12th, 2018)
 - Innovation project for industrial sector (dead-line October 10th, 2018)
- The PETROMAKS 2 work programme is a basis for all calls



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
Knowledge-building project for industry

- Applicant: A Norwegian research organisation approved by the Research Council
- In collaboration with Norwegian industry
- Funding:
 - At least 20 % cash from Norwegian industry
 - Maximum 80 % from the Research Council (not more than 4X industry funding)



The winners – the competition is tough

- Excellent project quality
- A clear answer to the call
 - How is the application relevant to the call and the objectives of the programme?
- Read the call thoroughly
 - Start early and get the right partners on board
- Respect formal requirements
 - No plus for anything else than what is asked for
 - The application risks rejection, if formal requirements are not fulfilled!
 - Ask when you are in doubt!
