


FORCE is a co-operating forum for Improved oil and gas recovery (IOGR) and Improved exploration (IE) between oil and gas companies and authorities in Norway.

- Membership/membership fee is regulated in FORCE cooperation agreement.









The aim of the agreement

Aiming to improve recovery from existing fields through collaboration and the use of new technology.

- To create a consensus that collaboration across licenses for piloting and testing is both cost and time effective and will increase the reserve base and reduce unit costs.
- To create a consortium for piloting approved by the companies, which provides the framework for rights and obligations between the parties.
- To regulate the execution and the financial relationship between the parties
- To define the organization of the project, progress, ownership and rights to use the results

This agreement is owned by 41 petroleum companies
